### VIADUCT/SR ROUTE 99 CLOSES PERMANENTLY TO ALL TRAFFIC TOMORROW AT 10PM

The Pike Place Market PDA is keeping a close eye on the SR 99 closure and demolition. As these projects progress, we are here to ensure continued visitor mobility in and around the Market.

Here is what you need to know as the first stages of this project are quickly approaching:

### 2019 VIADUCT KEY DATES

#### **January 11, 2019: Viaduct Closes at 10pm**

- The Alaskan Way Viaduct/SR Route 99 closes permanently to all traffic. Alaskan Way northbound into Seattle closed at Spokane Street, southbound to one lane through Battery Street Tunnel exit at Western.

#### **January 12, 2019: Temporary On-Street Parking Restrictions Downtown**

- To manage the increased volume of traffic on city streets, SDOT is restricting on-street parking on key streets downtown starting January 12 until the new SR 99 tunnel opens in early February. See diagrams and additional information on page two.

#### **January 31: Pike Place Market Surface Lots Close Permanently**

- Surface parking lots located at 50 Lenora St. and 30 Blanchard St. close permanently.

#### **Early February, 2019: The New SR Route 99 Tunnel Opens to All Traffic**

- Access to downtown only at Pioneer Square/Stadium District or Seattle Center/South Lake Union.
- For south end commuters: After the new SR 99 tunnel opens the northbound off-ramp to downtown will remain closed for up to two weeks.

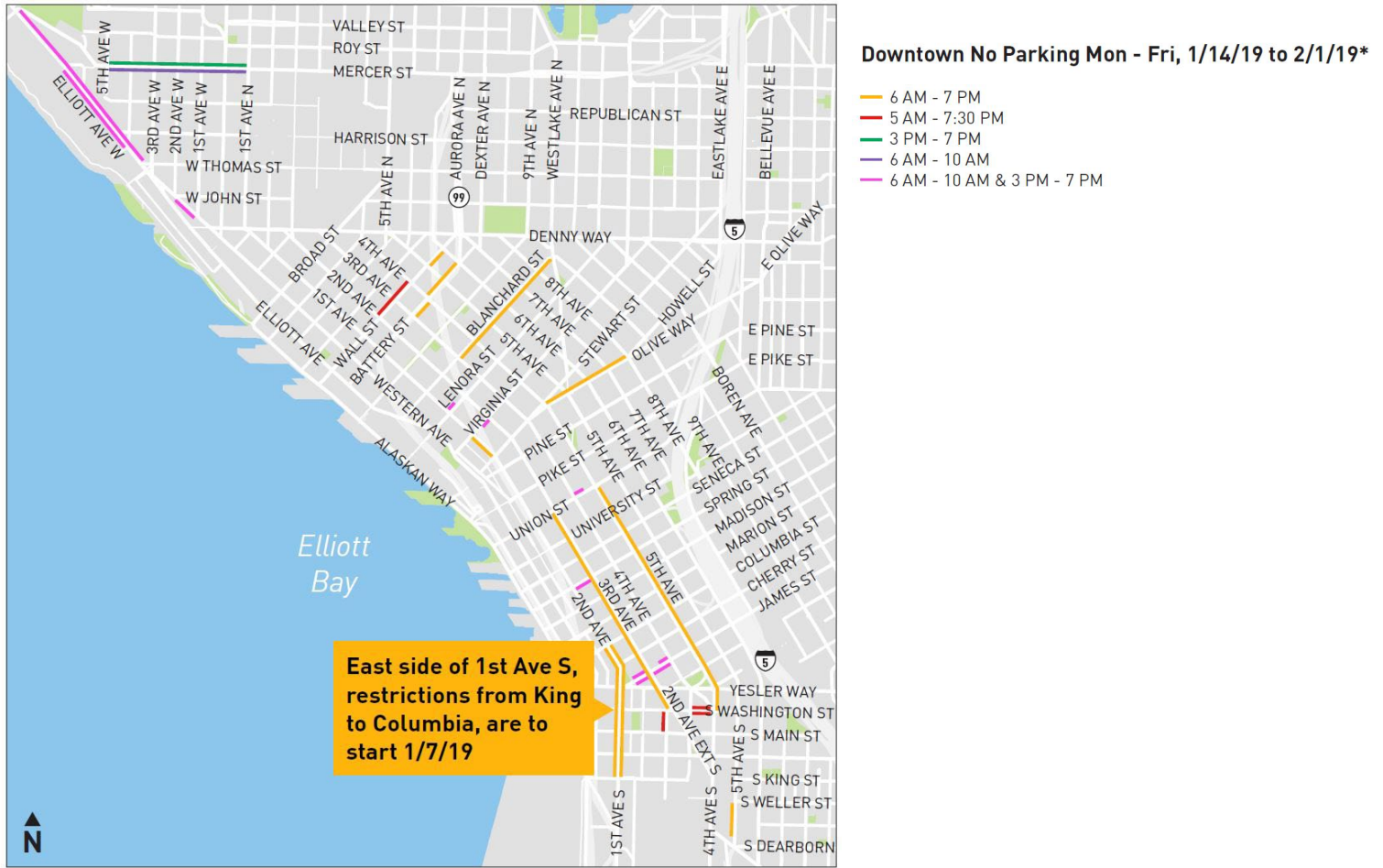
- Saturday, February 2: Tunnel to Viaduct 8K Run/Walk
- Sunday, February 3: Tunnel Bike Ride

#### **Mid-February, 2019: Viaduct/SR Route 99 Demolition (through July 2019)**

- Be prepared for increased noise and dust near the demolition site.

**TEMPORARY ON-STREET PARKING RESTRICTIONS DOWNTOWN:**

This map illustrates the locations and times on-street parking will be restricted. Signs will be posted beginning Friday, January 11.



**Seneca Street between 1st and 3rd to become a one-way street headed westbound on Saturday, January 12.**

Per SDOT: This is to accommodate the shift from the Alaskan Way Viaduct Seneca St off-ramp closing, as cars will no longer need to use Seneca St headed eastbound off of the Viaduct off-ramp. This change increases our city streets' capacity for mobility.
